

# ~Resurrection Rolls~

Tell the Story of Easter Through Baking

## Ingredients

- 1 Tube of crescent roll (Pillsbury, etc.)
- 8 Marshmallows (or one marshmallow per roll you plan to make)
- 3 tablespoons melted butter
- 3 tablespoon granulated sugar
- 2 teaspoons cinnamon

## Story and Instructions (Including verses)

1. Preheat Oven to 375 degrees
2. Combine Sugar and Cinnamon in a small bowl
3. Unroll Dough and Separate into triangles (There are usually already be partitions in the dough, but if not, just cut pieces large enough to completely cover a marshmallow)

The Marshmallow represents Jesus! Before moving to step 4, tell the story of how Christ was crucified.

"And they stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him, and twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on his head and put a reed in his right hand. And keeling before him, they mocked him, saying, 'Hail, King of the Jews!'... And When they had mocked him they...led him away to be crucified" Mathew 27: 27-31

4. Dip each Marshmallow in butter, then coat it in Cinnamon-Sugar mixture. When coated, place in middle of dough

The Cinnamon-Sugar mixture represents the oil and spices used to anoint Jesus's body after his death.

"The Women who had come with him from Galilee followed and saw the tomb and how his body was laid. Then they returned and prepared spices and ointments" Luke 23:55-56

5. Fold Dough around Marshmallow and tightly press together all seams  
The dough represents the tomb Jesus was buried in.

"And Joseph took the boy and wrapped it in a clean linen shroud and laid it in his own new tomb, which he had cut in the rock. And he rolled a great stone to the entrance of the tomb and went away" Mathew 27:59-60

6. Bake 8-10 minutes

Take a bite! When you look inside, notice how the marshmallow has disappeared! This means that Jesus is no longer inside his tomb and has risen from the dead!

"And behold there was a great earthquake, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled back the stone and sat on it...But the angel said to the women, 'Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. He is not here, for he has risen, as he said. Mathew 28: 2-6
